

1. PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

NO	CONTENT	REMARKS
1	Originality and Plagiarism	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All submitted papers must be original, not published elsewhere, and should not be under consideration for publication in any other venue.• Papers will undergo plagiarism checks, and any paper with significant overlap with previous work will be rejected
2	Formatting and Structure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Papers should follow the provided template and adhere to the following format• Title: Concise, clear, and relevant to the topic.• Abstract: Between 200-250 words summarising the objectives, methods, results, and conclusions.• Keywords: 3-5 keywords that represent the core content of the paper.• Body: Organized sections, including introduction, literature review, methodology, results, discussion, and conclusion.• References: Follow the specific citation style - APA style
3	Length	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Papers should be between 8-15 pages, maximum of 8000 words, including references, figures, and tables. A strict page limit must be observed unless stated otherwise.
4	Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Papers must be written in clear and grammatically correct English. Authors are encouraged to proofread papers before submission.
5	Submission Platform	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Papers must be submitted through the designated online submission system. Emailed or hard copy submissions will not be accepted unless explicitly requested by the organizer. Link submission: https://forms.gle/mXgN48FYJozTzd4G7
6	Deadlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All submissions must be completed by the stated deadline. Late submissions will not be considered unless extensions are announced.
7	Peer Review Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submissions will undergo a blind peer review process. Authors should avoid identifying information in the manuscript file to maintain anonymity
8	Revisions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Authors must address reviewer comments and resubmit revised versions by the deadline. Failure to do so may result in rejection.• Resubmissions are allowed up to two weeks following the symposium, with a final deadline of 13th December 2024.
